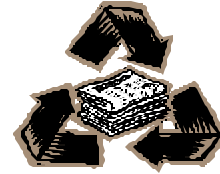

# PAPER



We take all types of paper and cardboard.

Extra help – We prefer your paper be in paper bags, boxes or tied with twine or in a reusable container because we have to remove all plastic bags before placing the paper in the trash truck. Sometime we have extra paper bags to hand out – ask at the book table.

# PLASTIC

We now take numbers  through  plastics!!!

◆ Remove the lids on bottles, but include them as part of your plastics ◆ Do NOT tie the handles of the bags in knots. ◆ Rinse out the containers ◆ Give us a large bag instead of a lot of small bags. ◆ We cannot recycle plastic shopping bags of any kind. ◆ No Rubbermaid, Tupperware or similar products unless the plastic symbol shows. ◆ No Styrofoam, such as egg cartons or meat trays even if marked with a recycling symbol. ◆ Please ensure that glass items or cans are not mixed with your plastics.
